YOU ASKED . . .

We have been receiving questions at the Temagami Senior Home Support and Temagami Non-Profit Housing Corporation about these organizations and how they operate. In response, we have decided to answer a few questions in the upcoming newsletters.

How did the Ronnoco House get its name?

- Dan O'Connor, considered to be the founder of Temagami, built the first hotel in this town which he named the Ronnoco Hotel (Ronnoco being O'Connor spelled backwards).
- The current Ronnoco House was built in 1988, at the location of the former Ronnoco Hotel

What is the relationship between the Temagami Non-Profit Housing Corporation (TNPHC) and the Temagami Senior Home Support (TSHS)?

- The TNPHC was established in 1987 and its initial project was to build seniors' rental units.
- Au Chateau Home for the Aged, based in Sturgeon Falls, donated \$155,000 to construct the Home Support wing of the Ronnoco House in exchange for a thirty-year lease
- Au Chateau was asked to provide services to the seniors in the Ronnoco House and to the seniors in Temagami. This way, Temagami could benefit from the funds the Municipality was required to pay Au Chateau each year.
- In Summary: TNPHC owns the Ronnoco House; Au Chateau leases the Senior Home Support Centre from the TNPHC.

BURNING PERMITS REQUIRED

Under Municipal by-law 11-976, Burning Permits for brush burning, burn barrels, and bonfires are required between April 1st and October 31st every year. Burning permits are not required for recreational campfires.
