**IMPORTANT FIRE SAFETY REMINDERS FROM THE  
TEMAGAMI FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Test smoke & CO alarms every month, have a home fire escape plan.

Ensure all entry/exits in your home are cleared from snow to ensure you can get out in case of a fire. Make sure all windows are not frozen in case you need to use these as an escape mechanism.

If there is a fire hydrant near your home you can assist the fire department by keeping the hydrant clear of snow so in the event it is needed, it can be located.

Avoid build-up of deadly CO. Keep intake & exhaust vents for furnaces and heating appliances free of ice, snow, debris. Ensure vehicles are not left running inside garage or building

In the kitchen, Grease and fat fires are a leading cause of home fires in Canada, so be extra careful when doing this kind of cooking. - See more on what to do if grease in a pot or pan catches fire at:
