BBQ Season is just around the corner.

At the start of the season, do this THREE-STEP SAFETY CHECK of your barbeque:

- 1 **CLEAN** Use a pipe cleaner or wire to ensure burner ports are free of rust, dirt, spider webs or other debris.
- 2 **CHECK** Examine hose leading from the tank to the burners. Replace if cracked or damaged.
- 3 **TEST** Find leaks by applying a 50/50 solution of water and dish soap to propane cylinder connections and hoses. If bubbles appear, tighten the connection and/or replace the damaged parts and retest.

All barbeque grills must only be used outdoors — using grills indoors or in enclosed spaces is not only a fire hazard, but it exposes occupants to toxic gasses and potential asphyxiation.

DO NOT place the BBQ close to wooden fences or walls, vinyl siding, or anything that can burn. The area behind your BBQ must be free of anything that can ignite – this is where hot gases escape.

Never leave a lit grill unattended.

When finished barbecuing, turn the gas valve off first, then turn off the burner controls so no gas is left in the connecting hose. Allow the BBQ to cool completely before closing the cover.

BURNING PERMITS REQUIRED

Under Municipal by-law 11-976, Burning Permits for brush burning, burn barrels, and bonfires are required between April 1st and October 31st every year. Burning permits are not required for recreational campfires. Further information on the burning by-law, requirements and permitting can be found on the municipal website under [Current Fire Situation](#).

Permits can be purchased through the municipal office.
