Cheaping out on your phone charger? You could get burned

Health Canada warns of safety hazards with several uncertified USB chargers

In March and April, Health Canada tested about 50 uncertified USB chargers bought across Canada and found 30 of them posed an unacceptable risk of electric shock and fire. *Those chargers, mainly sold at gas stations and dollar stores, have been recalled.*

If there is not a recognized certification mark on the product you should:

- **Immediately stop using the products above and either return them to the retailer where you bought them or dispose of them.**
- **Use only certified electrical products.**
- Provincial and territorial electrical codes require that all electrical products sold must be certified, which means that they meet the applicable Canadian electrical safety standards.
- Certified products can be identified by a recognized certification mark on the product.
- The certification mark must be on the product itself, not just the packaging. If you are unsure whether a product is certified, ask the retailer to show you the certification mark on the product before you buy it.

BURNING PERMITS REQUIRED

Under Municipal by-law 11-976, Burning Permits for brush burning, burn barrels, and bonfires are required between April 1st and October 31st every year. Burning permits are not required for recreational campfires.
