#### **FIRE SAFETY REMINDERS FROM THE TEMAGAMI FIRE DEPARTMENT**

### **Open Air Burning / Campfires / Burning Brush Q&A**

**When can I have a recreational camp fire?** Under both the Municipal Open Air Burning Bylaw and Ontario regulations 207/96 (Crown land) the permitted times to have a recreational fire is between 2 hours before sunset and 2 hours after sunrise during the Forest Fire season (April 1<sup>st</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup>)

**Is a permit required to have a camp fire?** A burning permit is not required to have a camp fire, HOWEVER, there are a number of requirements that must be met, including: construction of the fire pit, distance from combustibles and size of the clean Dry wood being burnt (*NO grass or leaves*).

**What if I want to have a larger fire / burn brush?** Under Municipal by-law 11-976, Burning Permits for brush burning, burn barrels, and bonfires are required between April 1<sup>st</sup> and October 31<sup>st</sup> every year. Under Municipal Burning bylaw, a burning permit is required for fires where the material being burnt, at any one time is greater than 60cm wide by 50cm high. Burning permits are also required for Incinerators/burn barrels. Burning Permits are not issued within the Urban areas of the Municipality, given the potential for these fires to have negative impacts on damage to property or smoke causing harm or material discomfort to neighbours. .

**Where can I get a Burning Permit?** Permits, for fires on private property are issued at the Municipal office, and can be purchased by the week, month or for the entire season.
