**IMPORTANT FIRE SAFETY REMINDERS FROM THE
TEMAGAMI FIRE DEPARTMENT**

1. Test smoke & CO alarms every month, have a home fire escape plan
2. Ensure all entry/exits in your home are cleared from snow to ensure you can get out in case of a fire. Make sure all windows are not frozen in case you need to use these as an escape mechanism.
3. Avoid build-up of deadly CO. Keep intake & exhaust vents for furnaces and heating appliances free of ice, snow, debris. Ensure vehicles are not left running inside garage or building
4. Do not burn wrapping papers in the fireplace. A flash fire may result as wrappings ignite suddenly, burn intensely and generate far too much heat - See more at: <http://www.oafc.on.ca/winter-fire-safety-tips>
5. In the kitchen, Grease and fat fires are a leading cause of home fires in Canada, so be extra careful when cooking with grease. - See more on what to do if grease in a pot or pan catches fire at: <http://www.oafc.on.ca/winter-fire-safety-tips>
6. If there is a fire hydrant near your home you can assist the fire department by keeping the hydrant clear of snow so in the event it is needed, it can be located.
7. Please take extra care while on roadways during the winter season. Ice & Snow – Take it slow - Better Late than Never!
