IMPORTANT FIRE SAFETY REMINDERS FROM THE TEMAGAMI FIRE DEPARTMENT

1. Ensure all entry/exits in your home are cleared from snow to ensure you can get out in case of a fire. Make sure all windows are not frozen in case you need to use these as an escape mechanism.
2. Test smoke & CO alarms every month, have a home fire escape plan
3. Avoid build-up of deadly CO. Keep intake & exhaust vents for furnaces and heating appliances free of ice, snow, debris. Ensure vehicles are not left running inside garage or building
4. Natural gas heat? Don't shovel snow up against gas meters or piping.
 - Snow or ice build-up on the gas meter or clogged/blocked exhaust vents could interrupt your gas service or cause an appliance to malfunction, which may create a hazardous condition.
 - To ensure proper functioning of your natural gas equipment and as a safety precaution, meters & vents should be gently cleared of any snow or ice. Use a broom or a brush to gently remove blockage and ensure that the areas remains clear of snow or ice. Do not use sharp objects or apply force as this may disconnect or damage venting. Don't kick or hit the gas meter, pressure regulator or piping to free snow or ice.
5. Fire hydrant near your home? Consider assisting Public Works in keeping hydrants clear of snow, providing quick access for fire department if required.
6. Please take extra care while on roadways during the winter season. Ice & Snow – Take it slow - Better Late than Never!
